## **Topics**

- Minutes Due to Janna's absents at the May meeting, Rick and Jill will combine notes to create Minutes.
- Treasurer's Report- Rick and Erica presenting. Money for the Gene Parks Fund has arrived from the Community Foundation but not yet posted. Tree planting donations are at \$1,475, Indiana American donations of \$3,500, CC Park benches and bricks fun around \$3,000. Signage/Artwork Grant has \$385 left, and other of \$100. This brings our current balance to \$15,031.74.
- **Bricks fundraising** Reba will start the process to get the engraving done.
- > Shelter and Playground- Team plans on meeting in late June.
- > Signage- Has a remaining balance of \$385. Tina Tate is to give an example of Signage.
- ➤ Caterpillar Project waiting on a final design and monies to complete. Discussed using Indiana American money for this project.
- ➤ Old Wheel Sculpture- Needed pea gravel, and brick placement, and plants, to finish. This is all to be done this July of 2021. Goal of August 2021 to have a Dedication of this sculpture along with the Crane.
- Recycled Bench Project- Twenty four fifty pound bags of caps have been collected, along with the monies to make purchases. Western Senior class started the sorting process on Community Service Day, and the remainder was completed by Jill, Reba, Rick, Janna, and Beth. UMC is purchasing several items. Current plan is to get six benches and a picnic table. Greg Landrum said he would take care of getting the caps to the bench factory, and returning with the purchased items. This should be done by late July 2021.
- ➤ Water Fountain Town Park- An area has been marked near the handicapped access for placement of the fountain. The fountain has not been installed.
- > Tree Donation- Barbie Casler donated a dogwood tree which was planted in the City Park.
- > Survey- A practice survey was taken during the RPTB meeting. After discussion it was decided to add the questions of (1) Quality of life? (2) Demographics of age/gender?

## **New Business**

➤ Circle Project- Jill gave quotes from two estimates for finishing the brick area around the CCP-Old Iron Wheel circle project. Back Yard Gardeners \$16,000. Travis Wunderlick \$8,890. Dave



- Lybrook never submitted a quote. Discussion on the brick color and pattern. It does not need to be circular.
- > Service Project by Cub Scouts- Board decided that preference would be given to the scouts making bluebird houses at their campout.
- Language in Town Park- Rick brought up the bad language that makes the park unusable by families with young children if some teens are present. He will bring it up at the Town Council meeting later this month.
